Sake waarvan die Sinode kennis neem Die persoonlike geestelike gesondheid van ‘n predikant is in die Rapport van die Omkeerdeputate uitgewys as ‘n kern aspek rondom die toerusting van predikante vir omkeer en groei in kerke. (vgl Acta 2015:511-514, 5.2.1.1-5.2.1.6.11). Daarom is eerstens hierop gefokus deur ‘n kamp van 4 dae gedurende April 2016 wat deur omtrent 30 predikante van regoor die land bygewoon is. Dit is opgevolg in die tweede helfte van 2016 met ‘n soortgelyke geleentheid vir Klassis KwaZulu-Natal Noord en Suid. Inligtingsdae is ook beplan vir Augustus 2017 oor opkomende geleenthede vir predikante om aan hul persoonlike geestelike gesondheid aandag te gee as grondslag om die gemeente op ‘n groei pad te kan begelei.</p> <p>Besluit: Kennis geneem.</p> <p>3. Matters that the Synod take note of The personal spiritual health of a minister has been pointed out in the report of the turn-around deputies as a key aspect for the training of ministers for repentance and growth in churches. (Cf. Acta 2015:511-514, 5.2.1.1-5.2.1.6.11). Therefore, it was focused on during a 4-day camp in April 2016, attended by about 30 ministers from all over the country. It was succeeded in the second half of 2016 with a similar opportunity for Classis KwaZulu-Natal North and South. Information days are also planned for August 2017 on upcoming opportunities for ministers to pay attention to their personal spiritual health as a basis for guiding the congregation on a growth path.</p> <p>Decision: Noted.</p> <p>3.
